This transition has been difficult, but do-able, and an experience that Lenora and I needed to assure us of how He wants to use us in our remaining years. The stability we have both for us and the ministry has truly been God-sent. Your prayers have been heard and answered. Since associating with Victory Baptist Church in Milton, Florida, in January, their arms of hospitality have wrapped themselves around us. We have been in the pulpit and pew, wine and dined, published and preached to. Their love, friendship, and support have given this old fisherman and his wife joy and encouragement in the ministry.

Our ministry endeavors are healthy at this time (radio, Bible schools in India and Philippines, and the big Bangladesh project). The printing part of this ministry is on hold at this time. Please take a glimpse at our website from time to time to see changes.
